HygroMatik has launched two additions to the CompactLine range: the new electrode steam humidifiers CompactLine CO1 and CO2. The CO1 and CO2 have a steam output of 1 and 2 kg/h to produce a rapid and controlled steam.

The CO1 and CO2 produce optimum hygienic humidification with exceptionally clean steam that is produced directly from tap water.

Both the CO1 and CO2 have a unique

blow-down pump to carry small hardener particles into the drain to ensure the longevity of the cylinder's service cycles. In fact, the steam cylinders are completely reusable and can be cleaned without the need for additional chemicals.

Each steam humidifier within the CompactLine range comes with a variety of high quality components in a long lasting, stainless steel and corrosion-resistant cabinet. The CO1 and CO2 can also come with an optional fan unit for direct room humidification and remote control.

The CO1 and CO2 have quality guaranteed as they are certified with VDE, GS and CE for the optimum steam humidification.

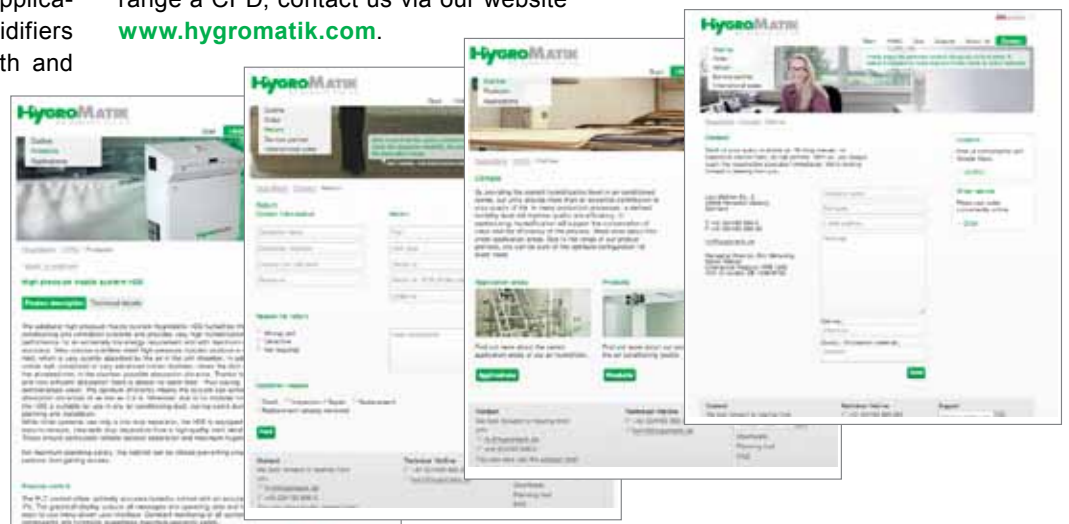
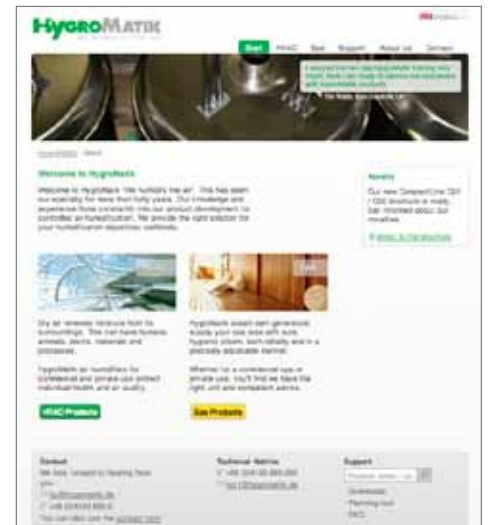
